



## JUNIOR & SENIOR CLUB PERPETUALS

---

### Club Perpetual Guidelines

The Club perpetuals referred to in this document are those perpetuals that are linked directly to the club and the final decision on the winning recipients lay with the Committee of the club.

The Club awards two major perpetual trophies in the Junior and three major perpetuals in the Senior age groups. Presentation of trophies will occur at the end of the season at the respective break up / presentation evenings. Trophy winners must return the trophy prior to the end of that season in the following year. These awards are presented annually, however if the nominations are deemed unsatisfactory, awards may not be presented.

#### Junior trophies are:

- Coach of the Year
- Club Member of the Year

#### Senior trophies are:

- Golden Boot
- Best Performance in a Club Game
- Club Person of the Year

Being awarded one of the above Club Perpetuals is an honour for club members and should retain its prestige and not be awarded without substantial consideration.

### Nomination & Process

1. The Club should call for nominations directly at the end of the normal competition rounds of both the Junior and Senior competitions.
2. The nomination period should remain open for two (2) weeks only.
3. Nominations should be completed on the Club nomination form, signed by the nominating member and passed to the Secretary.
4. In the event that the nominee is serving on the committee at the time of the nomination, that person must be disqualified from any deliberation on the nomination.
5. Once a nomination is received, the Secretary shall have the responsibility of calling a 'special meeting' of executive committee members to decide on the nomination/s.
6. At the meeting, the executive committee must discuss the application/s, in regard to the criteria and determine if the nomination is worthy.
7. A simple majority of quorum of the executive committee is sufficient for the nomination/s to be pursued.
8. Where there is more than one nomination to be considered, the executive committee will undertake a secret ballot vote to determine the awarding of the winner of the perpetual trophy.

### Criteria

#### Golden Boot

The winning recipient of this award will be based on the player who has scored the most goals in the respective senior season. The final results used for this award will be those results from the Senior North Queensland Football (NQF) Competition results table. (finals series is not included).

### **Best Performance in a Club Game**

This award can be presented to an individual or a team who has highlighted exceptional performance in a game / games during the Senior NQF Competition (also extends to the finals series of the competition).

### **Coach of the Year**

Consideration will be given to junior coaches who have demonstrated some or all of the following:

- Made a positive impact by increasing participation and/or inspiring and encouraging others to improve.
- Inspired young players and encouraged greater participation, promoting fair play and making the sport more welcoming and inclusive.
- Instilled positive values in their players.
- Coaching achievements during the last 12 months.
- Applied appropriate and accepted training theory and coaching principles to improve the level of performance of the team and/or the individual players.
- Presented a positive image of coaching and the role of a coach.
- Acted as a role model and a positive influence on the community.
- Demonstrated respect for officials, opponents and supporters.

### **Club Person / Member of the Year**

The Club has many people that contribute their time and resources to helping the club each year. These contributions are highly valued and whilst we cannot always recognise everyone's efforts, we do attempt to recognise some of the more significant contributions by way of our Club Person/Member of The Year award. The purpose of this award is to acknowledge outstanding individuals who have shown dedication, commitment and made a significant contribution to football in our Club.

The Club Person/Member of The Year award seeks to recognise the contribution of a person who has worked tirelessly throughout the season, without the expectation of recognition and for no financial or personal gain, for the overall benefit of the club and its members.

We are looking for a person who has shown commitment, dedication or support beyond the 'norm'.

This person does not have to be an office bearer or have a specific job. They could be on the committee, be a coach, manager, parent, player or general supporter.

Some additional criteria that can be considered to choose the right person may include: (but not limited to);

- Person who;
  - continually volunteers for Canteen / Fundraising / Event duties
  - assists coach/manager
  - knows their club members, parents, supporters and players
  - helped with working bees
  - always acts in the best interest of all Club Members
  - encourages good sportsmanship and equity
  - works honestly with all Club members in a team environment for the advancement of the club
